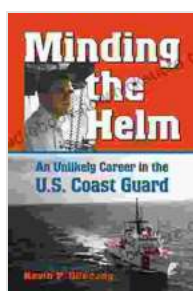


An Unlikely Career in the Coast Guard: North Texas Military Biography and Memoir

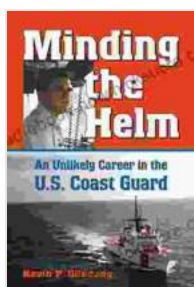
