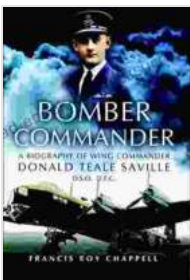

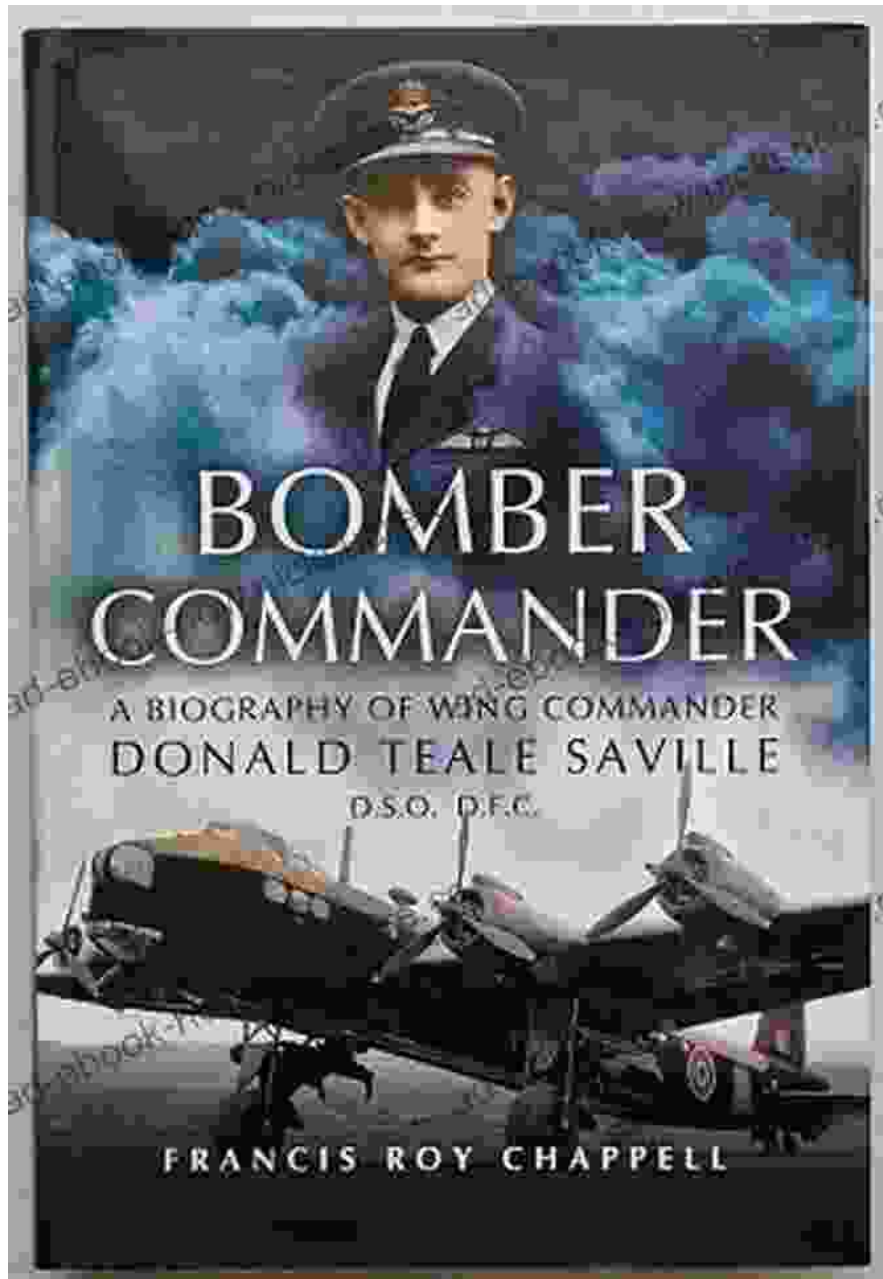

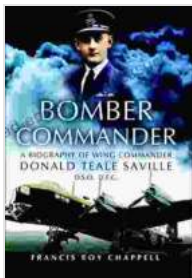

RAF fighter squadron

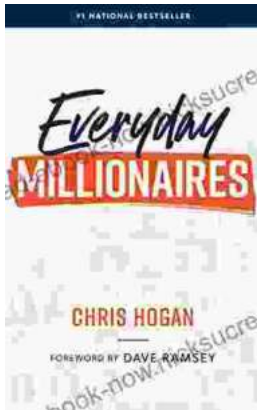

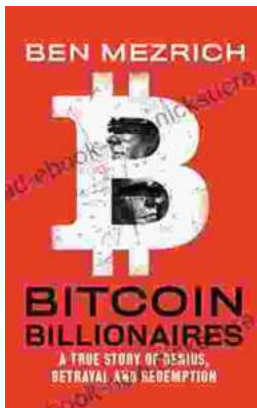
