Getting Started

- A mandolin
- A tuner
- A chord chart

Open Chords

Open chords are the easiest chords to play on the mandolin. They're played with all four strings open, and they only require you to fret two or three strings.

The following are the basic open chords:

- C major (C)
- G major (G)
- D major (D)
- A minor (Am)
- E minor (Em)

To play an open chord, simply place your fingers on the frets indicated in the chord chart and strum all four strings.

Barre Chords

Barre chords are more difficult to play than open chords, but they allow you to play a wider range of notes. Barre chords are played by placing your index finger across all six strings at a certain fret. This creates a "barre," which allows you to fret multiple strings with one finger.

The following are the basic barre chords:

- F major (F)
- Bb major (Bb)
- Eb major (Eb)
- Ab major (Ab)
- Db major (Db)

To play a barre chord, place your index finger across all six strings at the fret indicated in the chord chart. Then, place your other fingers on the frets indicated in the chord chart.

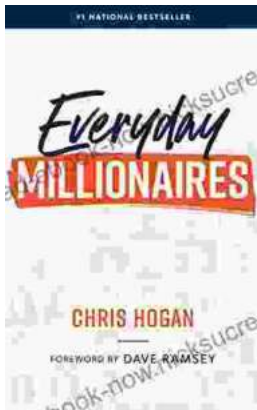

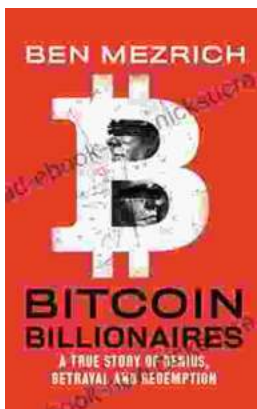
