
Elizabeth, Camilla, Kate, and the British Throne

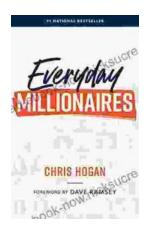
