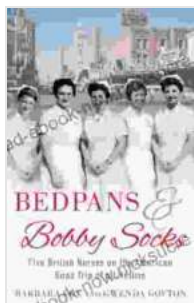


Five British Nurses Embark on the American Road Trip of a Lifetime

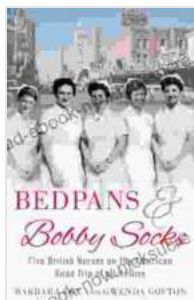
