


From High School Dropout to Billion Dollar Tumblr Webmasters



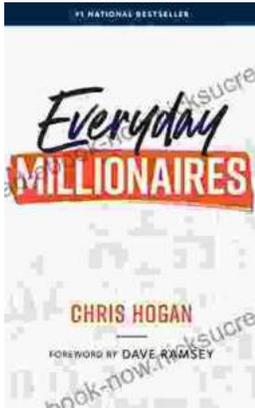

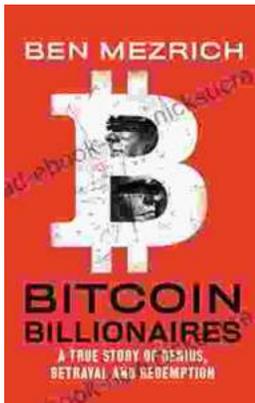
