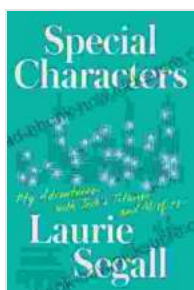


My Adventures with Tech Titans and Misfits

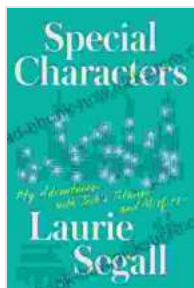

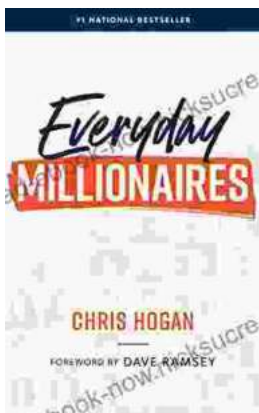
