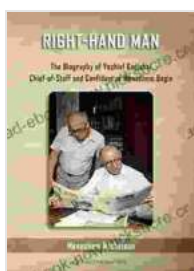

Early Life and Education

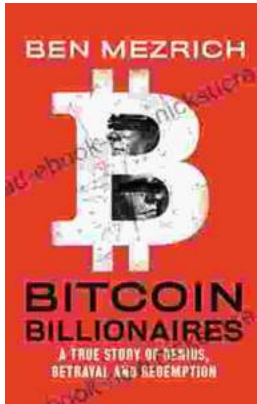
