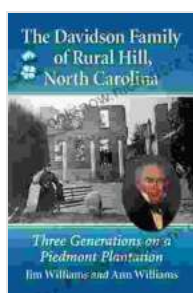

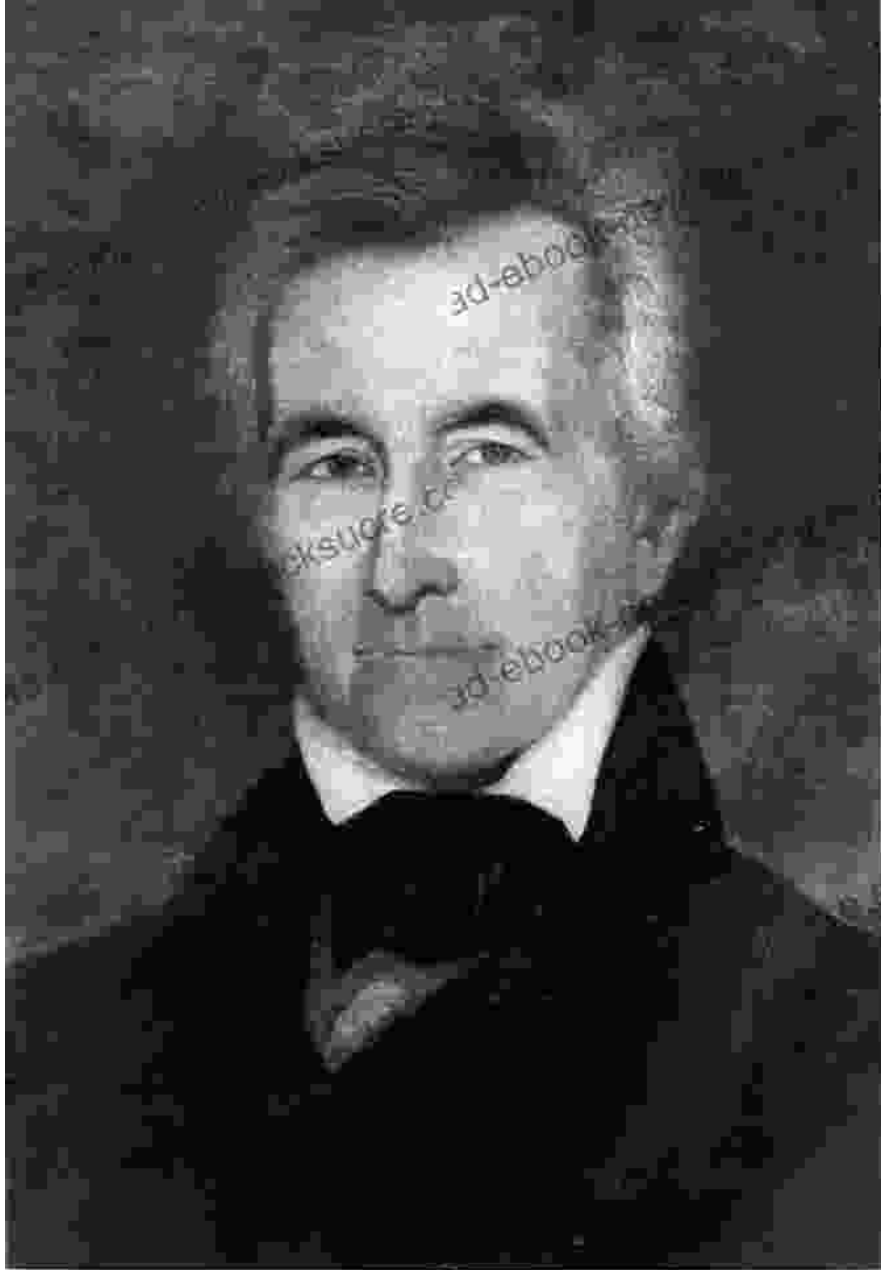

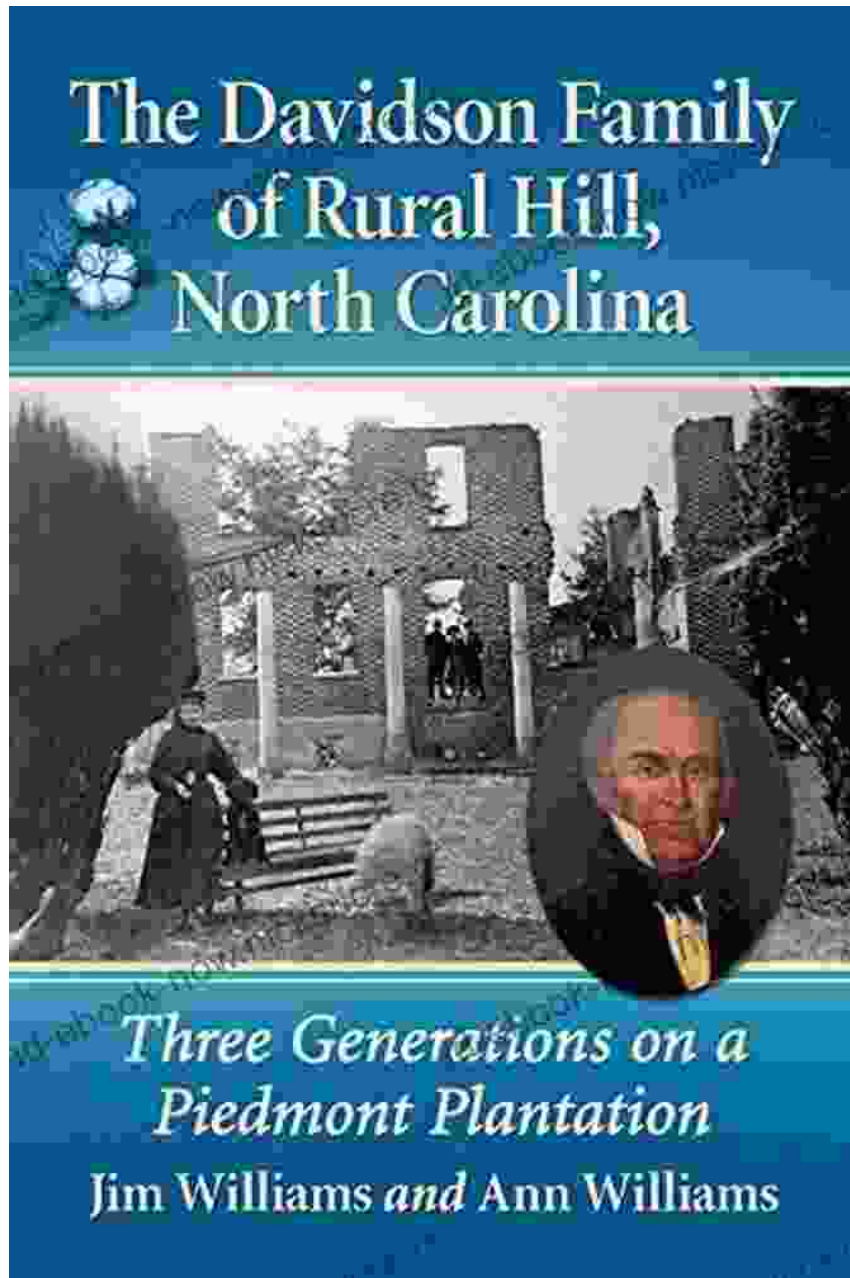
General William Lee Davidson: A Revolutionary War Hero

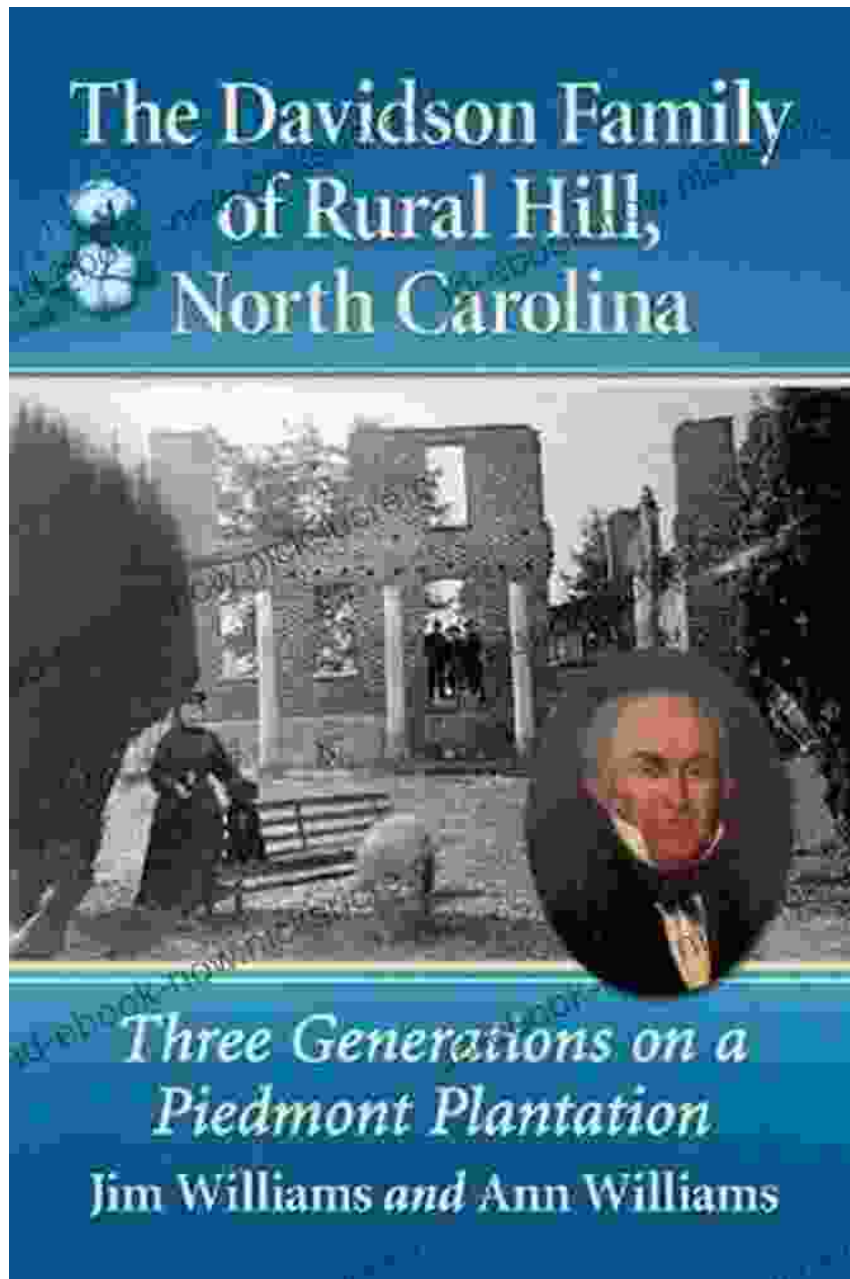
Dr. Robert Davidson: A Pioneer in Medical Education

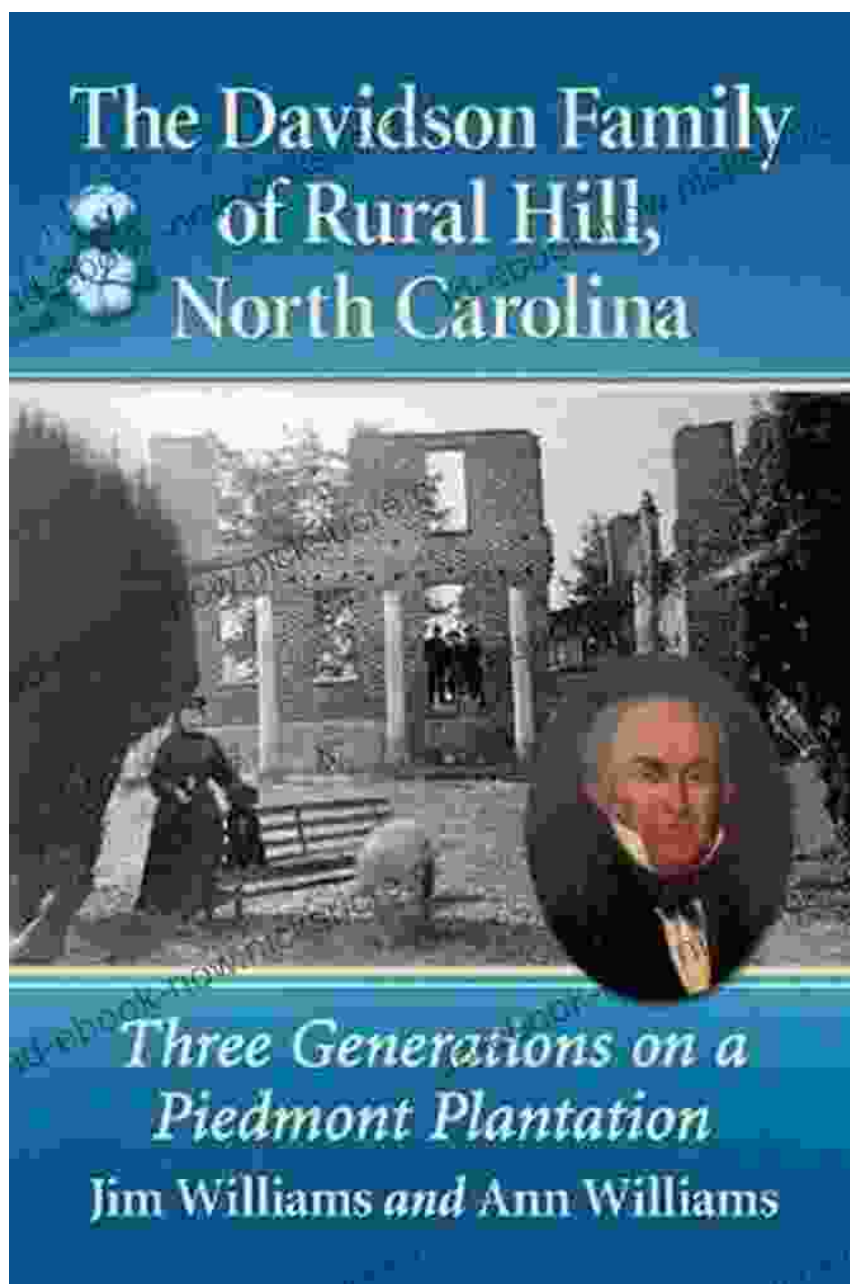
John Davidson: A Philanthropist and Social Reformer

Rural Hill Today: A Living Legacy

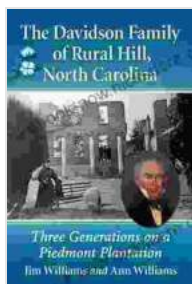


Today, Rural Hill Plantation is a historic site owned and operated by the Davidson County Historical Society. The plantation house, built in 1792,

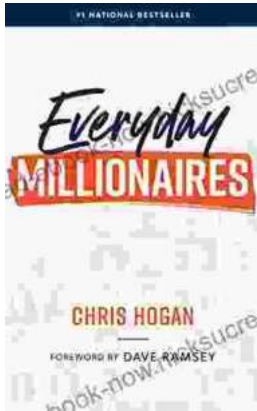

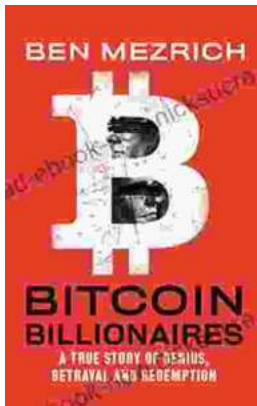
